Arizona Driving Test Review Questions

The following questions will help you check your grasp of the knowledge needed to obtain an instruction permit or driver's license. Like those on the official exam, they are taken from the Arizona Driver License Manual. Be sure to thoroughly study the manual before taking the test. A score of 80% or higher is required to pass the actual exam.


