## **HIGH SCHOOL & COLLEGE PREP CHECK SHEET**

The minimum requirements for a basic diploma are suggested for students who have educational goals that require flexibility; they may be less appropriate for students who plan to attend a baccalaureate-granting institution. Students are strongly advised to check with the college of their choice to make sure this coursework will meet the particular requirements of that college. Students are encouraged to choose courses from more than one discipline but may select courses related to those already taken in order to develop greater depth in one or more subject areas. Additional elective courses not listed below may be more appropriate depending upon the unique needs and academic goals of the student. Students must complete a total of 20-22 units of credit. (1 credit = 1 full year; .5 credit = 1 semester.) Students enrolled in a dual enrollment class may be granted college credit along with high school credit.
